JOINT RESULTS MATRIX (2006-2010 PROGRAMME CYCLE)

AREA 1. SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOODS AND POVERTY REDUCTION

Outcome 1.1: Poverty decreased

Sub-outcomes:

- 1.1.1: Improved poverty monitoring and mapping system
- 1.1.2: National planning processes incorporate poverty eradication strategies
- 1.1.3: Improved data quality for formulation of social policies
- 1.1.4: Business climate improved
- 1.1.5: Socially vulnerable groups have access to financial resources and information materials

AREA 2. HEALTH IMPROVEMENT

Outcome 2.1: HIV/AIDS epidemic halted

Sub-outcomes:

- 2.1.1: Increased access to HIV prevention services and information
- 2.1.2: Improved access of PLWH to treatment, care and support

Outcome 2.2: People are better protected from the risks detrimental to their health and development

Sub-outcomes:

- 2.2.1: Improved access to reproductive health services
- 2.2.2: Improved healthy lifestyles and information
- 2.2.3: Improved access of Chernobyl-affected population to quality health care services

Outcome 2.3: TB spread halted and reversed

AREA 3. EFFECTIVE AND ACCOUNTABLE GOVERNANCE

Outcome 3.1: More participatory and effective governance system, which respects and promotes human rights as contained in the international standards

Sub-outcomes:

- 3.1.1: Professionalism of civil service increased
- 3.1.2: More transparent and accountable governance system, discouraging corruption

- 3.1.3: More participatory governance system with a stronger self-governance at the local level
- 3.1.4: Respect for human rights, including rights of vulnerable groups (disabled persons, refugees and asylum seekers, children, women, HIV infected, stigmatized IDUs) increased

AREA 4. MIGRATION MANAGEMENT AND COMBATING ORGANIZED CRIME

Outcome 4.1: Enhanced migration management, including border management, with safeguards to protect persons who need international protection

Sub-outcomes:

- 4.1.1: International standards of protection for migrants/asylum seekers/refugees are adhered to
- 4.1.2: Increased capacity of the state to improve migration management and to cooperate within the region
- 4.1.3: Increased participation of relevant non-state actors in monitoring, provision of assistance and future planning
- 4.1.4: Increased public awareness on migration issues
- 4.1.5: Greater local integration opportunities for refugees

Outcome 4.2: Improved government capacities to combat crime (drugs, human trafficking, smuggling)

Sub-outcomes:

- 4.2.1: International standards as regards combating smuggling, drugs and human trafficking are met
- 4.2.2: Increased capacity of law enforcement agencies to apprehend, prosecute and convict
- 4.2.3: Increased participation of relevant non-state actors
- 4.2.4: Increased public awareness on the need to prevent crimes and to protect the victims

AREA 5. ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION

Outcome 5.1: Environmental sustainability enhanced

Sub-outcomes:

- 5.1.1: National capacity to contribute to effective climate change mitigation enhanced
- 5.1.2: Healthy environment promoted for the benefit of people

AREA 6. CHERNOBYL (CROSS-CUTTING)
